



10. "GPAT, NIPER, DI, Pharmacist



In total, an estimated 500 million lack access to menstrual products and adequate facilities for menstrual hygiene То management (MHM). effectively manage their menstruation, girls and women require access to water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) facilities, affordable and appropriate menstrual hygiene materials, information on good practices, and a supportive environment where they menstruation without can manage embarrassment or stigma. The challenges that menstruating girls, women, and other menstruates face encompass more than a basic lack of supplies or infrastructure.



While menstruation is a normal and healthy part of life for most women and girls, in many societies, the experience menstruates continues he of to constrained by cultural taboos and discriminatory social She norms. expressed that the resulting lack of information about menstruation leads to unhygienic and unhealthy menstrual practices and creates misconceptions and negative attitudes, which motivate, among others, shaming, bullying, and even gender-based violence. She guided that the multi-dimensional issues that menstruators face require multi-sectoral interventions. WASH professionals alone cannot come up with all of the solutions to tackle the intersecting issues of inadequate sanitary facilities, lack of information and knowledge, lack of access to affordable and quality menstrual hygiene products, and the stigma and social norms associated with menstruation.

2. Teacher Day






1. Environment Field Trip




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2. INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY



5.Computer Aided Drug Design: Rational Approaches in Medicinal Chemistry

Computer Aided Drug Design means In-Sillico techniques in the field of the Drug Design and Development. It plays the important role in the drug discovery and development activity. Discovery and development is the very complex process but it is simplified and reduces the costing of the Practical work in laboratory with reducing valuable time also. Hence In-sillico techniques reduce time, money, manpower. The Major approaches in CADD include Structure based drug design and Ligand based drug design. Both these Direct acing and In-direct acting types respectively. The Structure based drug design related with identification of target which is protein. This is determined by X-ray, Crystallography, homology modeling and NMR Spectroscopy. Various chemical compounds Structures are interacted with biological protein on virtual screening method. By using this process the score and ranking is to be obtained on the basis of electrostatic, hydrophobic, steric interactions of these chemical structures with active site of the target protein. Finally those are to be top ranked and having the good scored only tested for Biological assays.

Target identification and validation is the initial step in it. Then it go for analysis structure for potential ligand sites. Molecular Docking shows the interaction between lead and receptor sites. After Validation and optimization of the compounds sends towards clinical trials. So various processes are to be done in case of structure based drug design.

It appears to be most effective technique in case of drug design and discovery. It gives more potent drug candidates by reducing the unwanted properties such as poor efficacy, poor ADMET by using in silico filters.



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In case of Ligand based drug design target protein structure is not known. On the basis of lead structure it should be known that where ligand to be bind on desired target site. In this way all possible modification are to be done to develop the phamacophore of molecule so is should possesses all required features for binding with target site. Ligand based technique is phamacophore based technique and Quantitative structure activity relationships method. Ligand based drug design shows that t hose structures having similarity in size and shape hey are showing the same biological action and interaction with target site. Molecular Docking is insillico method shows the interaction of molecule within the active site of their target protein and receptor.
