World has become a small village as we can communicate with each other in fraction of second. This is the new era for communication, new era for a change. In this new world there only thing which is stable & that is change.

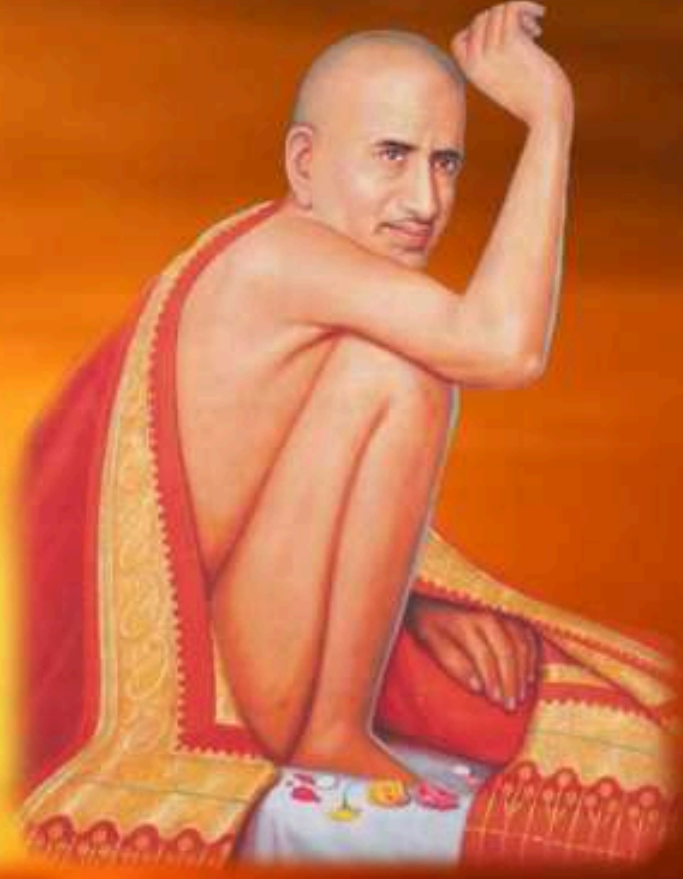

## 20. Nirbhaya kanya Abhiyan

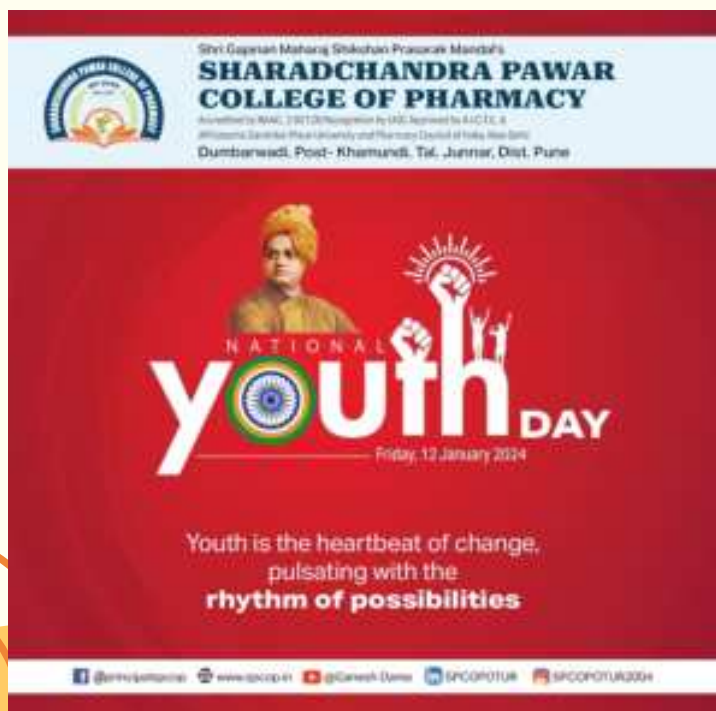

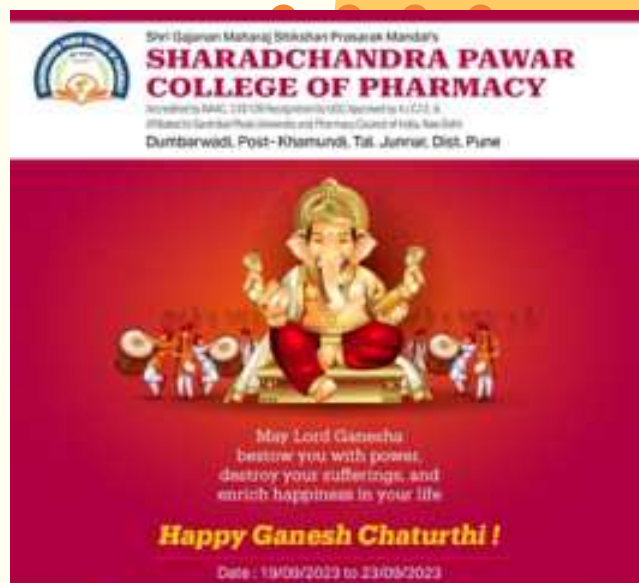
## 1. Farewell Ceremony

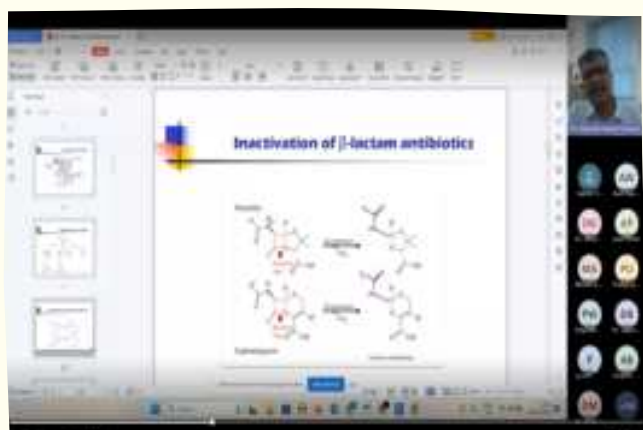
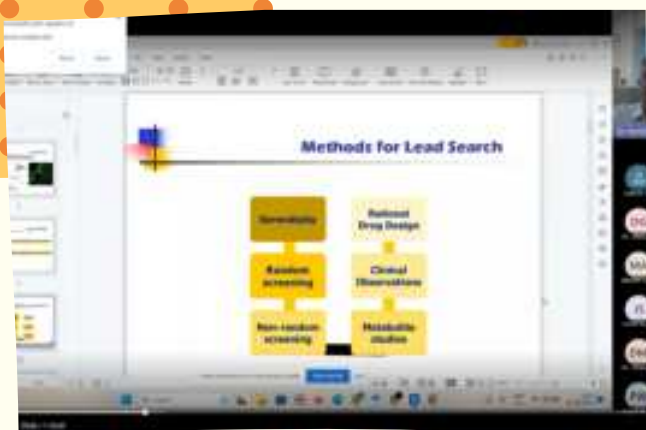

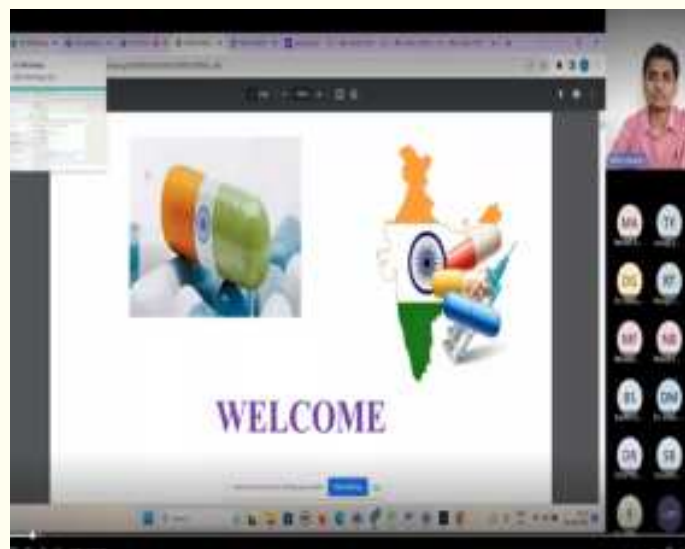

## 6. Swachhata Abhiyan

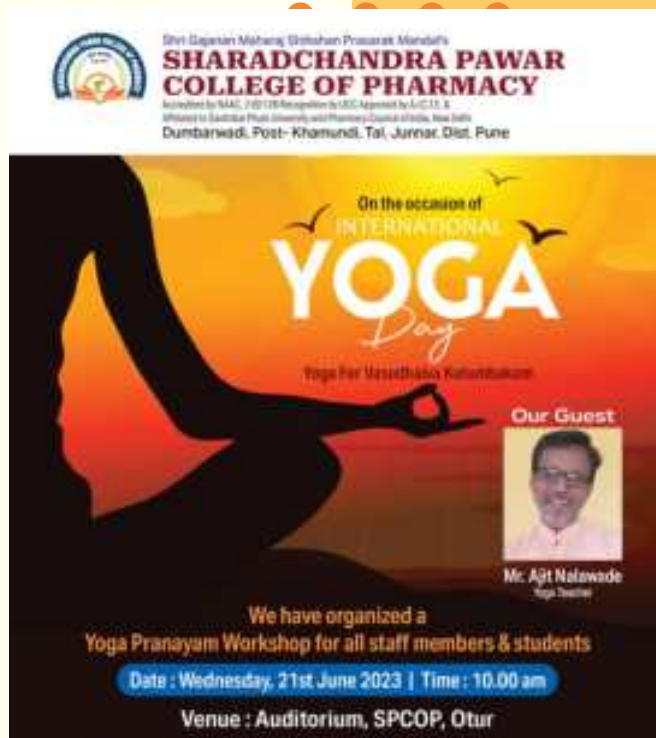

## UNDERSTANDING QSAR IN GREEN CHEMISTRY: A PATH TOWARDS SUSTAINABLE INNOVATION

---

In the pursuit of sustainable solutions, green chemistry has emerged as a revolutionary approach, focusing on reducing the environmental footprint of chemical processes and products. One of the most significant tools aiding this movement is the Quantitative Structure-Activity Relationship (QSAR) model. QSAR connects the molecular structure of chemicals to their biological or chemical activities, enabling predictions about how new compounds will behave. This not only helps in designing safer chemicals but also reduces reliance on resource-intensive testing methods. QSAR models are mathematical relationships that predict the activity of chemical compounds based on their molecular structures. In essence, the model draws connections between a compound's structure and its various physical, chemical, or biological properties. Historically, QSAR has been widely applied in drug discovery to predict the pharmacological properties of new molecules. However, in recent years, it has become an invaluable asset in the field of green Chemistry.

The principles of green chemistry are aimed at minimizing the use and generation of hazardous substances. QSAR supports this by predicting the potential harm a chemical could cause before it is even synthesized.

This preemptive approach aligns well with the core tenets of green chemistry, offering several distinct advantages:

- One of the fundamental goals of green chemistry is to design chemicals that are safe for human health and the environment. QSAR models can predict the toxicity of a chemical based on its molecular structure. By identifying toxic functional groups or structural elements, chemists can avoid creating hazardous compounds, thus reducing the risk of harm.
- QSAR also helps assess the biodegradability of chemicals. By predicting how long a compound will persist in the environment, scientists can prioritize the development of molecules that break down quickly and safely, minimizing long-term ecological damage.
- Green chemistry benefits by focusing on chemicals that will not accumulate in ecosystems or contribute to persistent organic pollutants (POPs).

## Phytochemistry in drug discovery

### Biological activities of phytochemical:

The phytochemicals found in plants that prevent illness and enhance health have been the subject of in-depth research to determine their effectiveness and comprehend the underlying mechanisms of their action. These investigations have included the identification and separation of the chemical constituents, as well as the determination of their biological potency through epidemiological and clinical-case control studies in humans as well as in vitro and in vivo research in experimental animals. The results of the study indicate that by avoiding the oxidation of low-density lipoprotein (LDL) cholesterol, lowering the production or absorption of cholesterol, restoring blood pressure and clotting, and enhancing arterial flexibility, phytochemicals may lower the risk of coronary heart disease.

Phytochemicals have the potential to detoxify carcinogens. They seem to block carcinogen-activating enzymes, neutralize free radicals, and activate enzymes that detoxify carcinogens. Meagher and Thomson's summary of the findings indicates that genistein, for instance, inhibits the development of new capillaries, which are necessary for tumor growth and metastasis. Few phytochemicals have well-understood physiological characteristics, and a growing body of research has examined their potential use in the treatment or prevention of heart disease and cancer.

### Flavonoids:

Polyphenolic substances called flavonoids are widely found in the natural world. There are around 4,000 known flavonoids, many of which may be found in fruits, vegetables, tea, coffee, and fruit drinks. The usage of flavonoids has continued to this day, possibly due to their significant contribution to ancient effective medicinal therapies. Approximately 650 flavones and 1030 flavanols are known to exist within the portions of plants that people typically ingest, and more than 4000 flavonoids have been characterized thus far.
