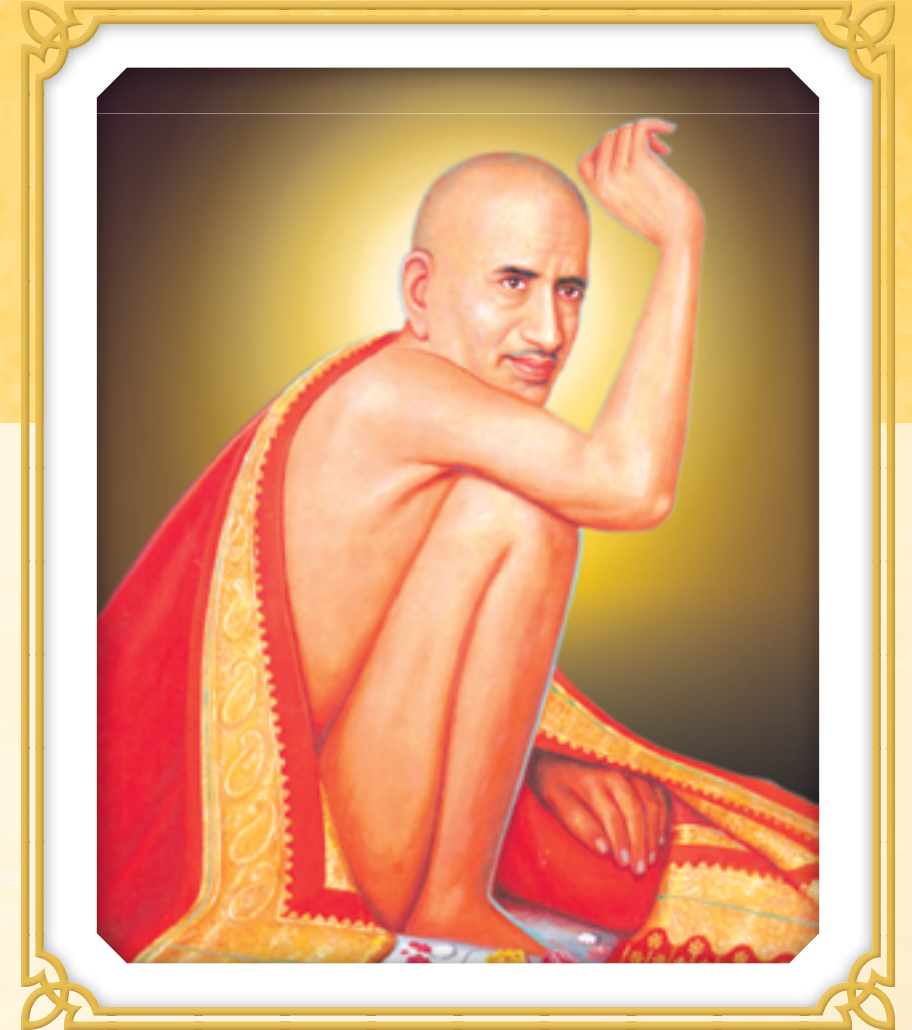

quality of pharma education can make a difference.

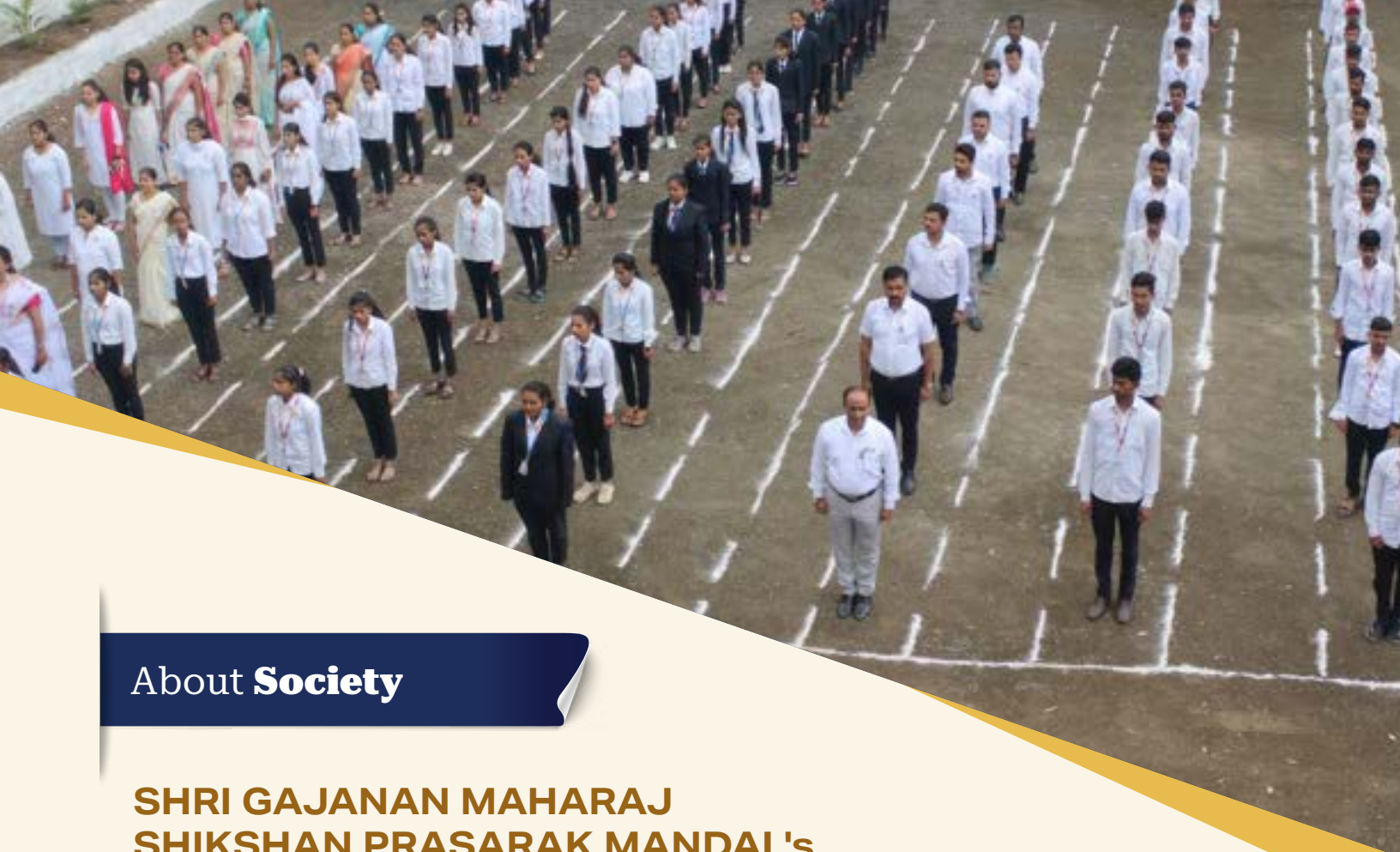

INTRODUCTION :

Sharadchandra Pawar College of Pharmacy (SPCOP) located centrally at equidistance from four major cities like Pune, Nashik, Ahmednagar & Kalyan (Mumbai). SPCOP was established in Year 2004 with the aim to provide higher and professional educational facility to the students from rural territory.

SPCOP has a target to promote innovation in the profession of Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Sciences by developing budding Pharmacist through using imagination & creativity with view to secure through innovative techniques having positive impact in community. The college is housed in a spacious building of about

70,000 sq. feet constructed area amongst the lush green and quiet surrounding.

The college boasts of spacious and modern Laboratories consisting advanced equipments and instruments costing of about 50 Lakh. These well equipped laboratories gives complete exposure to students that meets the modern industrial requirements. Spacious & calm library with adequate furniture & No. of latest books with e-Journal Facility, well ventilated specious classrooms along with LCD projectors make the environment enjoyable to study.

To achieve this **Sharadchandra Pawar College of Pharmacy (SPCOP)** will ensure the highest quality of faculty,

resources and infrastructure. This center for academic excellence shall be recognized in India as one of the top centers for imparting quality programmes in Pharmacy disciplines for the consistently high standards of output through opening new avenues of career in Pharmaceutical education.

Approvals & Affiliation :

The college is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, for the purpose of course study, Syllabus and conduct of examination & award of Degree and Master Degree. The Institute is affiliated to Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai for the purpose of course study, syllabus and conduct of examination & award of Diploma.

Eligibility :

A) Maharashtra state candidates.

An Indian National Candidate passed HSC or equivalent examination with PCB or PCM group and English with minimum 50% (150/300) marks and 45% (135/300) marks for backward class category candidate of Maharashtra state.

B) OMS Candidate

Candidate passing HSC or equivalent examination from college out of Maharashtra will be consider as "out of Maharashtra" candidate. The candidate passed HSC or equivalent examination with PCB/PCM group and English with minimum 45 % marks.

C) Direct S.Y. - B.Pharma

Diploma holder candidate passed diploma in Pharmacy with minimum 50% marks from the institute approved by AICTE in Maharashtra State or out of Maharashtra State.

Registration Certificate :

After Completion of this Course Student should apply with supporting documents to the Maharashtra State Pharmacy Council for the Registration Certificate.



FACILITIES & INFRASTRUCTURE :

Research / PG Laboratories :

Research/PG Laboratories are well equipped with modern machinery and Instruments to impart knowledge and research skills among the PG students. The machinery & instruments provide a tool for training the students to handle and operate it at institute level which in turn help them to inculcate the operating and handling skills to meet industrial requirements. These well equipped PG Laboratories help to train students in various practical & projects in subjects like Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutics & Quality Assurance Techniques.

Pharmaceutics :

Pharmaceutics laboratories developed with advanced machine room and aseptic preparation room with highly sophisticated instruments and equipments like tablet manufacturing machine, pan coating, ball mill, capsule filling machine, ampule filling machine, ointment filling machine.

Brookfield viscometer, ostwold viscometer, single stage dissolution test apparatus, hardness tester, friability tester, colony counter, laminar air flow, HEPA filter and autoclave etc. Which are used for formulation and development of different Pharmaceutical dosage forms like tablet, capsules, syrup, solution, suspension, emulsion, eye, nose and ear drops, ointments etc. and their characterization in Biotechnological, Pharmaceutical, Microbiological, Analytical aspects.

Pharmaceutical Analysis :

Pharmaceutical analysis laboratories are equipped with highly sophisticated instruments like FTIR, HPLC, single beam and double beam UV- Spectrophotometer, Flame photometer etc. which is used for doing high level research activity and industry based research.

Pharmaceutical Chemistry :

Pharmaceutical chemistry laboratories are timely updated with sophisticated instruments and assembly required for synthesis of organic compounds and for their characterization. Assemblies like steam distillation, fractional distillation, dean-stark assembly, high vacuum



distillation apparatus, slab-gel electrophoresis, digital melting point, apparatus, Infrared lamp, Keep's apparatus etc. are used for synthesis of organic compounds and characterization.

Pharmacology :

The department of Pharmacology is having various sophisticated instruments like Actophotometer, Radiant Heat Analgesiometer, Plethysmometer, Electro- Convulsometer, Pole-Climbing apparatus, ECG, Y- Maze Apparatus, Digital students organ bath, Autoanalyzer etc. and a well constructed animal house.



Pharmacognosy :

The college has given a lot of emphasis on developing spacious medicinal garden and modern pharmacognosy laboratories which are equipped with hot air oven, incubator, muffle furnace, UV cabinet, microscope, centrifuge and high quality mixer which are helpful for students to apply their theoretical knowledge into practices, in area of plant origin drug, research, their chemical constituents, adulteration and standardization of crude drugs.



Research Laboratories :

The college has all kinds of modern and ultra modern instruments and machineries required for performing several research works. The total cost of the equipment is more than 1 crore and college spends 30% amount of the total budget for purchasing & maintenance of the equipments annually.



Pharmaceutics Research (PG) :

Pharmaceutics research laboratory are developed with highly sophisticated instruments and equipments like multistage tablet manufacturing machine, pan coater with spray nozzle, Brookfield viscometer, digital six station dissolution test apparatus, Pfizer hardness tester. These instruments are utilized for the manufacture of various dosage forms and carrying their characterization.

Quality Assurance (PG) :

Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance (QA) research laboratory is having modern equipment like high performance liquid chromatography (HPLC), Ultra Violet Spectroscopy (UV), Fourier Transfer Infrared Spectroscopy (FTIR). In the pharmaceutical industry, quality assurance is essential for ensuring that pharmaceutical product are manufactured to a safe and consistant standards.

QA professional are responsible for instituting range of practice that help gurantee drug quality.



Computer & Internet facility :

The college is well facilitated with more than fifty computers of latest configuration connected by wireless local area network and internet 10 MBPS Reliance broadband line with unlimited internet browsing facility to the students.



Medicinal Plant Garden :

The college has 550 sq. meter land for medicinal garden which contain more than 105 medicinal plants. It also serves as a conservation source of standard specimens.



Other Amenities :

- Pure and cold hygienic drinking water with high quality Aqua Guard filter.
- Special common rooms, for boys & girls.
- Locker facilities to keep their belongings.
- Canteen facility for delicious breakfast and meal.

Sport & Cultural Activity :

The college campus has a 5 acres playground. For building sport skills in the students and make them all rounders college provides sport trainer and all kind of sport facilities (Viz. cricket, football, volleyball, table tennis to the students.)



Extra Co-curricular activities :

The cultural events conduct about a week with number of events culminating into cultural programme. The event brings forth the organizational and hidden skill of the students & provides them a chance to rediscover themselves. Students also regularly participates in other inter college events held time to time.



Training & Placement :

Every academic year college arranges industrial tours for students to make them aware about industry and current market trends and also outshine their communication



skills and personality. Up till now various industrial tours had been organized by college at various places in India, which are Varanasi-2007, Delhi-2008, Ahmadabad -2009 and Manipal 2010, IPC- 2012 (Chennai) & IPC-2013 (Delhi), Saitech-2017 (Sinner), Mr. Health & Hygine- 2019 (Kolhapur). Students of passed out batches were placed in various reputed National and Multinational companies (Viz. Lupin, Cipla, Glaxo, SmithKline and Hindustan Antibiotics) through campus placement and are working at various posts with handsome packages.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Student should strictly obey the instructions given by the Principal I Director from time to time.
2. The Student should be regular in attendance and his/her attendance for the day shall be marked only when he/she is present for all the sessions during the day. Minimum 75% attendance is compulsory for grant of term. If the student is found irregular in attendance, he/she shall be expelled from the College.
3. The Student found guilty of an act of misconduct either in the College or outside shall be subjected to strict disciplinary action and may be expelled from the College.
4. The student should carry identity card with him regularly and the identity card should be produced when demanded by the authority of the institute. Any changes in the address of student must be intimated by him/her in writing to the college office immediately.
5. The student is required to submit the assignment failing which he/she shall be subjected to disciplinary action.
6. The Vehicles should parked on place notified and the vehicles parked elsewhere i.e. Other than parking zone shall be confiscated.
7. Student should drive safely inside the campus as well as outside the campus. For two wheeler users, use of helmet is compulsory.
8. The student should not cause any damage to the institute's property. The damage caused shall be recovered from student immediately.
9. The attendance for the tests and tutorials conducted in the College is compulsory.
10. The student showing consistently poor performance in the tests and tutorials & failing the internal evaluation of the subject shall not be sent for the university examination.
11. If the student is found weak in certain subjects he/she will have to attend extra classes as notified and make the required progress to come at par with the other students.
12. Strict silence should be observed in the library. Loitering in corridors is strictly prohibited.
13. The student coming late shall not be allowed to enter the class.
14. The student should read the notices displayed on the notice board regularly and the College will not be responsible for the loss or any disadvantage due to negligence of reading notices on the part of the students.
15. In case, a student requires to remain absent for some reason, he/she will be required to take the prior permission of the Head of the Department / Teacher co-ordinating.
16. Use of the phones/cameras/camera phones is prohibited in the campus.
17. Smoking, drinking (alcohol) and use of 'Drugs' is strictly prohibited in the college premises and the hostel.
18. Mal-practices during all examinations and tests will be taken seriously and disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulters. Punishment for mal-practices during examinations would be very serious and may involve debarment from examination for a period up to 5 years.
19. Ragging of students in any form within or outside the college and hostel is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be strictly dealt with as per anti ragging ordinance.
20. If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the student to college authorities is found to be false or incorrect later on, his/her admission will be cancelled, fees for feited

- and he/she will be expelled from the college and prosecuted as per rules if deemed necessary.
21. The above rules of discipline are always subject to change, modification, addition, omission, alterations as and when the Management feels it fit and proper and the decisions of the Management shall be final.

Anti-ragging Rules & Regulation :

UGC regulation on curbing the menace of ragging (under section 26 (l) (g) of the university grant commission act, 1956 New Delhi - 110002, the 17th June 2009)

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the institute.

1. Ragging within the Institute campus and hostels is strictly prohibited.
2. Ragging in any form is prohibited also in the private lodges! buildings where these institute students are staying.
3. No person including students! staff! faculty shall participate or abet or propagate ragging in any form.

What constitutes ragging ?

- (a) Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student.
- (b) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological or physical harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.
- (c) Asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
- (d) Teasing, embarrassing, humiliating, assaulting or using criminal force or criminal intimidation, wrongful restraining or confining or causing grievous hurt, kidnaping, and extortion or molesting or committing unnatural offences or causing death or abetting suicide, use of criminal force, criminal trespass and intimidation.

Punishments :

Ragging is a cognizable offence under the law and the punishments to be meted out have to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent.

It may include :

- (a) Cancellation of admission, suspension, rustication or expulsion from the Institute / Hostel.
- (b) FIR with the police and arrest.
- (c) More severe punishment where justified such as fine / imprisonment etc.
- (d) Collective punishment may be imposed where involved persons are not identified.

Refund of fees :

After confirmation of admission, if cancelled

- (a) Within one month 25% deduction of fees,
- (b) After one month no return of total fees in any circumstances.

In case of following reasons -

- i. Severe accident of the student making him to stop the education,
- ii. Death of the student.
- iii. Any other reason which makes the student to stop his education. Total Fees of the two / four year's course will be incurred from the student! parent.
