NARCOTIC DRUG

It means coca leaf, cannabis (hemp), opium and poppy straw including all manufacturing drugs

PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCE

It means any substance natural or synthetic or any salt or preparation of such substance or material, which is included in the list of psychotropic substance specified in the schedule

CLASSIFICATION

1 Cannabis (hemp): Used to produce hemp fibre and as a drug

2.Coca: American shrub, source of cocaine.

Ganja



It is flowering/fruiting tops cannabis plant.

Charas



Resin in crude or purified form obtain from cannabis.

OFFENCES

- Punishment for contravention in relation to Ganja
- Punishment for contravention in relation other them Ganja

PENALTIES

- Rigorous imprisonment upto 5 years with a fine upto Rs 5000.
- Rigorous imprisonment for not less than 10 years with fine not less than Rs 1lakh which may extends to Rs 2 lakh.

Coca derivative: manufacture of cocaine. Eg. Ecgonine

Leaf of Erythroxylon plant. Eg.0.1%of cocaine

OFFENCES

> Punishment for contravention in coca leaf & plant.

PENALTIES

Rigorous imprisonment for not less than 10 years with fine not less than Rs 1lakh which may extends to Rs 2 lakh

3.Opium: coagulated juice of opium poppy.

Opium Derivative



All preparations containing more than 0.2% morphine.

Opium poppy



Derived from papaver Somniferum

Poppy straw



Include part of opium poppy after harvesting.


OFFENCES

Punishment for contravention in relation to poppy straw

PENALTIES

Rigorous imprisonment for not less than 10 years which may extend to 20 years with fine not less than Rs 1lakh.
