






















#### 10. CELEBRATIONS OF WORLD'S SCIENCE DAY








### 19. CELEBRATION OF MAHATMA GANDHI JAYANTHI

### 23. CELEBRATION OF SWAMI VIVEKANANDA JAYANTI






#### 27. CELEBRATION OF REPUBLIC DAY







#### 29. CELEBRATIONS OF NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY




## GENDER DISCRIMINATION
