





SGMSPM's, Sharadchandra Pawar College of Pharmacy has organized seminar on the 27th July 2019. The focus of the seminar was "Pharmacovigilance, Regulatory Affairs & Clinical Trials". The seminar theme was designed to improve the awareness of students in the field of regulatory affairs. Pharma-Regulatory Affairs act at the interface between the pharmaceutical industry and drug regulatory authorities across the world. Its function is to ensure that pharmaceutical products to be marketed meet all the

regulatory expectations with regards to quality, purity, safety and efficacy. In addition. confirms it also the appropriateness and accuracy of product information. Mrs. Archana Gawade madam discussed about all the basics of regulatory affairs like its key role in pharmacy, its worldwide scope, its responsibilities like, statutory regulatory documents, grant and renewal of regulatory licences, preparation of regulatory closures, filing & follow up at national and regional levels.



2. Trends In Drug Discovery And Drug Development

SGMSPM's Sharadchandra Pawar college of Pharmacy, Dumbarwadi, otur was organized lecture on "Trends in Drug Discovery and Drug Development" on 12th March 2020 The lecture was delivered by an eminent speaker Dr. Masood Sidhhiqui Principal Royal College of Pharmacy, Malegoan, Nasik. Dr Masood Sidhhiqui has about fifteen years of research experience in preclinical research with reputed pharmaceutical industry like Glenmark, Ranbaxy, Jubilient Life Sciences etc. During this period he had handalled drug discovery projects on Respiratory system, Antidiabetic drugs, antiinflammatory drugs etc in coordination

with reputed MNCs. He also has Four years of academic experience as a Principal. In this lecture Dr Massod shared his experiences in preclinical research during his research tenure in industry. He unfold the stages of drug discovery from having an idea about the drug to develop for, study of chemical nature of the lead, Formulation and devlopment, Invivo and invitro study, New Drug Application (NDA)/ (ANDA), Clinical research (Phase I - IV) up to introduction of the formulation in the market. He also added on various animal model methods for various studies.

Students with the college infrastructure, administrative, instructional facilities and amenities within premises of college, induction program was held on 22nd Aug 2020. 4. Installation of Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine And Napkin Incinerator–An Initiative By Women Development Cell

SGMSPM's Sharadchandra Pawar college of Pharmacy, Dumbarwadi, otur has successfully installed Sanitary Napkins Vending Machine and napkin incinerator in Girl's Common Room on 5th September 2019. The vending machine was installed to ensure an effective, safe and convenient mode for any time access to sanitary napkins. The purpose is to promote safe and hygienic- sanitary practices among women and girls of SPCOP. Whenever any girl in the college would need a sanitary napkin, she would either have to ask the Faculty in charge or rush to a nearest medical store to purchase a pack of sanitary napkins. Mrs. Shital J. Bidkar said that a social taboo was observed to be attached with sanitary napkins, wherein a majority of girls and women hesitate to go to medicine outlets to buy them. This results in unsafe practices and the use of unhygienic materials during their menstrual period. Using a sanitary napkin

vending machine is no rocket science. A girl requiring a sanitary pad needs to put a Rs. 5 coin in the machine and outcomes the sanitary napkin. On the same day the Electric Incinerator was also installed in SPCOP. The electric incinerator provides an environment-friendly alternative for disposal as they convert each sanitary napkin into one milligram of sterile ash. These machines would bring relief to sanitary workers in institution where these products are collected and burnt. Menstrual hygiene management (MHM) refers to the creation of an ecosystem that allows women and girls to experience menstruation in a safe and dignified manner. Mrs. Shital J. Bidkar, head of Women Development Cell said that this is the need of the hour and will ensure hygienic practices among girl students. It is likely to bring down absenteeism during menstrual periods, as well as prevent infections and promote hygiene.



5. Preparation of Civil Services Examination and MPSC-UPSC Foundation Course










49. Voter's Day





When you have symptoms of cold, flu, COVID-19 (coronavirus) or other viruses and infections, properly wearing a surgical facemask can help protect others from getting sick. It is important that you follow infection prevention precautions when putting the mask on and taking the mask off. If you are one of those people who need to wear a facemask, follow these instructions for how to put on and take off a surgical mask. There are several types of facemasks. The most common are: Medical (or surgical) masks - for general public use N95 particle respirator masks – for health care professionals How to Put the Mask On Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Dry your hands with a clean paper towel and throw the paper towel away. Check the mask for any defects such as a tear or missing tie or ear loop. Throw away any that are defective. Make sure the exterior (usually yellow or blue) side of the mask is facing out, away from your face. Place the mask on your

face with the blue side facing out and the stiff, bendable edge at the top by your nose. If the mask has ear loops, put one loop around each ear. If the mask has ties, pick up the mask by the ties and tie the upper ties behind your head with a bow. Once the mask is in place, use your index finger and thumb to pinch the bendable top edge of the mask around the bridge of your nose. If the mask has a lower tie, then once the mask is fitted to the bridge of your nose, tie the lower ties behind your head with a bow. Make sure the mask is completely secure. Make sure it covers your nose and mouth so that the bottom edge is under your chin. Wash your hands. Wash your hands before removing the mask. Do not touch the inside of the mask (the part over nose and mouth). It may be contaminated from your breathing, coughing or sneezing. Untie or remove the ear loops and remove the mask by the straps. Throw the mask in the trash. Wash your hands.



SPIRULINA: A PRECIOUS NUTRACEUTICAL

a biomass of cyanobacteria Spirulina is (blue-green algae) that can be consumed by humans and animals. Three species of it are available *viz*. Arthrospira platensis, A. fusiformis, and A. maxima. Arthrospira is world spred variety used as a dietary supplement or whole food. It is also used as a feed supplement in the aquaculture, aquarium, and poultry industries. It consists of photosynthetic bacteria that cover the groups Cyanobacteria and Prochlorophyta. This algae represents an important staple diet in humans and has been used as a source of protein and vitamin supplement in humans without any significant side-effects. Spirulina has been used to support a number of health conditions, including fatigue, high cholesterol. high triglycerides, and viral infections, benefits also include weight loss, increased energy, and stimulation of the immune system. Spirulina is a high-nutrient, low-calorie food that contains a lot of nutrition in a small amount of powder. Just like plants, cyanobacteria can produce energy from

sunlight via photosynthesis. Spirulina is a fantastic source of antioxidants, which can protect against oxidative damage. Its main It lowers total cholesterol, "bad" LDL cholesterol and triglycerides, while raising "good" HDL cholesterol. Spirulina has anti-cancer properties, Spirulina reduce blood pressure in individuals with normal levels. This reduction is thought to be driven by an increased production of nitric oxide. In case of anaemia, spirulina supplements increases the haemoglobin content of red blood cells and improve immune function. Spirulina appears beneficial, to improved muscle strength and endurance. This is mixed into the culture medium and allowed to grow. It should be regularly agitated using an electric pump or by stirring manually. The temperature, pH and concentration of algae should be monitored. Once the concentration increases to about 0.5g/L it must be harvested. This can be done by simply filtering it through a cloth to obtain a "biomass" of about 10% dry matter per litre.
