### **Ozar :**

The Vighneshwar Ganapati Temple or also known as Vigneshwara Temple of Ozar (Ojhar/Ojzar) is a Hindu temple dedicated to the Lord 'Ganesha' or 'Ganpati Bappa' Son of Lord Shiva and Parvati, the elephant-headed god of wisdom.



### **Lenyadri :**

Girija's (Parvati's) Atmaj (son) is Girijatmaj. Girijatmaj Ashtavinayak Temple is the only temple of the Ashtavinayak which is on a mountain and is built in the locale of Buddhist Cave. Girijatmaj Ashtavinayak Lenyadri Ganpati temple is the sixth Lord Ganesha Temple to be visited on the Ashtavinayak Mandir Pilgrimage.



### **Shivneri Fort :**

Shivneri Fort is a 17th-century military fortification located near Junnar in Pune district in Maharashtra, India. It is the birthplace of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of Maratha Empire. Here are statues of Jijabai and young Shivaji inside the fort.



### **Nane-Ghat :**

Nane Ghat is a mountain pass in the Western Ghats range near Junnar in Pune district of Maharashtra, India. During the reign of the Satavahana, the pass was extensively used as a trade route between Kalyan and Junnar.



### **Mhalshej Ghat :**

Malshej Ghat is on Kalyan Nagar road. Though it is popular as a rainy tourist yet, it is soon evolving as a place of perennial cooling, like Mahabaleshwar and Matheran. The hill surrounded by a dense shawl in the rainy season makes the tourists go mad. Now there are special points being created for tourists visiting Ghat.



### **Bhimashankar Temple :**

Bhimashankar Temple is an ancient shrine Hindu temple. This temple is present in the Sahyadri hills in Maharashtra, India. The Bhimashankar temple situates in the village of Shiradon, about 568 km northwest of Khed, close to Pune.
